

To fit head circumference, approx: 56-60cm (22 -23½ in) Height, approx: 22cm (8½ in)

Materials: 100g of Schachenmayr original Sun City Protect in shade 00474 (pine).

Milward 4mm (UK 8/US 6) needles. Large tapestry needle.

 $\begin{array}{l} \textbf{Tension:} \ 20 \ \text{sts} \ \text{and} \ 32 \ \text{rows} \ \text{to} \ 10 \text{cm} \ (\text{main patt}) \ \text{on} \ 4 \text{mm} \ \text{needles} \\ \text{or size needed to achieve correct tension.} \end{array}$ 

Abbreviations: K=knit; P=purl; st(s)=stitch(es); dec=decrease by working 2 sts together; beg=beginning; patt=pattern; K2tog=knit next 2 sts together; sLIP=slip next st purlways; sL2K=slip next 2 sts together as if to work K2tog; p2sso=pass 2 slipped sts over; meas=measures; fall=following; rem=remain(ing); approx=approximately; RS=right side; cm=centimetres; in=inches; mm=millimetres.

## INSTRUCTIONS

With 7 mm needles, cast on 109 sts.

**Rib row 1:** (RS), \*K3, P3; repeat from \* to last st, K1.

Rib row 2: P1, \*K3, P3; repeat from \* to end.

Repeat these 2 rows for 3cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Work in patt thus:

**Row 1:** ( $\overline{RS}$ ), \*K4, sLIP (keeping y arn at back of work), K1; repeat from \* to last st, K1.

Row 2: P.

Rows 3 and 4: As rows 1 and 2.

Row 5: \*P3, KI, sLIP, KI; repeat from \* to last st, Pl.

Row 6: K1, \*P3, K3; repeat from \* to end.

Rows 7 and 8: As rows 5 and 6.

These 8 rows form patt.

Work in patt until Hat measures 12 cm from cast-on edge, ending with RS facing for next row.

## Shape too

**Decrease row:** Patt 14, \*K2tog, patt 16; repeat from \* 4 times more, K2tog, patt to end (103 sts).

Work 1 rnw.

**Decrease row:** Patt 13, \*K2tog, patt 15; repeat from \* 4 times more. K2tog, patt to end (97 sts).

Work 1 row.

**Decrease row:** Patt 12, \*K2tog, patt 14; repeat from \* 4 times more, K2tog, patt to end (91 sts).

Work 1 row.

Continue as set, working I st less before each decrease on every alternate row until 19 sts rem. Work I row.

**Next row:** \*sL2K, K1, p2sso; repeat from \* to last st, K1 (7 sts).

Break yarn and thread through rem sts and draw up tightly. Join back seam.
